Dear Friends and Family,

Hope this finds you enjoying some wonderful summer sunshine and making memories with your family and friends! It is hard to believe that it is almost the end of July – time is going by so quickly. It has been over 7 months now since Clair has gone to Glory, but his memory and the work he started, still carries on, in the hearts and lives of so many people, both here at home and in Africa. We have been told by Pastor Luke in Zambia, that many people, in the remote areas, still ask about Clair, as they have limited communication and had not heard of his passing. But overwhelming, the work that the Lord started, through Clair and Beautiful Feet Ministry, has had a huge and far-reaching impact of spreading the Gospel in the rural areas of Africa, and we praise God for this! May the Lord continue to have his hand upon the mission that was started.

We have now added Pastor Luke to our board of directors, and so appreciate his insight, wisdom, and vision for the ministry in Africa. It has been so good to hear of the wonderful stories of hundreds of people coming to know Christ as their personal Saviour. Pastor Luke said one of the motorcycle evangelist had traveled hundreds of kilometers to a remote island region, where the gospel had NEVER been shared before. The response was overwhelming and many communities and tribal chiefs continue to ask for the evangelists to come and show the Jesus film in their villages. Praise God for the Harvest field! Pastor Luke also said that they have now been showing the Jesus film during the days following a funeral in the area. For a funeral in Africa, there is a gathering of several hundred to well over a thousand people from different tribes and areas. This has been a blessed opportunity to share the love of God with those that are hurting and searching for answers.

In our last newsletter in May, we had hoped that Pastor Luke and Noriah would have been able to come to Saskatoon, to share with us and our supporters about their work with Beautiful Feet Ministry. Unfortunately, their visas were never processed, to our knowledge. We hope that we will be able to try again, in the near future and set up meetings for everyone to meet and hear from them.

On June 2nd, we were able to hold our volunteer book sorting day out at Redekop Manufacturing. We are SO THANKFUL for the many volunteers that were able to come out and help sort through 9-10 pallets of books that were in storage. We still have about another 10 pallets of books that will need to be sorted. We hope to hold another sorting day in the fall – we will keep you posted about a date and time. Our storage is quite full at this time, but we are hoping to get another storage container in place soon. Thank you to Christian Salvage mission and all who have donated these precious books to help build bible college libraries and provide new pastors with much needed resource material.

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We are thankful for the new Jesus Film projectors and the motorcycles that have now been put in place over the last 2 months. Most recently, the 12 Jesus Film projectors were delivered to Tanzania by a team from Malawi. We are grateful for the dedication and desire that these Pastors and evangelists are putting forth to reach their countries with the Good News of Jesus Christ. We are humbled and thankful to God for the latest reports below, from December 2022 to June 2023 for Zambia, Malawi, Mozambique, Rwanda/DR Congo, and Uganda:

We plan to get training in place for Tanzania soon and look forward to getting reports from them as well. For now, they have started showing the Jesus Film in the primary schools in their community. This is part of the teachers mandate to teach the word of God twice a week in the school. They are grateful for the Jesus Film projectors to be able to start these showings in the school. Prayer requests:

The fuel support for the evangelists has been a crucial part of the ministry's ongoing needs. Most of these evangelists do not have adequate funds to support both their families and the fuel for travel to show the Jesus Film. Many travel hundreds of kilometers each month, to bring the Good News to these remote villages. We want to be able to send \$100/month for each of the Jesus Film backpacks to help with fuel. Your support for this area of the ministry would be greatly appreciated.

Uganda – the evangelists, in one region, have been stopped by local leaders from showing the Jesus Film. They are demanding Police letters authorizing the evangelists to show the films. Please pray that this issue will be dealt with and the ban would be lifted.

Malawi – 3 boys from Muslim background gave their lives to Christ and have started attending Sunday School classes. Please pray for these boys as they learn more about Jesus and share with their families.

Rwanda – heavy rains and flooding in one region destroyed the home of one of the motorcycle evangelists and over a 100 people were killed in the flooding. Please pray for this region and the families affected.

Church plants in all regions are looking for financial support for roofing and building materials.

Chichewa Bibles are needed for the new churches started in Malawi, Mozambique, and Zambia. The cost is \$10.00 per Bible. We are looking to purchase 500 Bibles at this time.

Norlah, Pastor Luke's wife, continues to be one of the most amazing, busy labourer for her Lord and Saviour.

Norlah shares with school girls the feminine hygiene program and includes the Gospel message- 350 girls gave their lives to Christ last month!



Norlah continues to work with families that have children with disabilities. She brings them your gifts from the container - many of these children have never received a gift, or even recognition in their entire lives! What a blessing this is to brighten a child's day, by showing God's love through these gifts.



Norlah also helps women who have been left to support themselves and their children. She teaches sewing for the women to learn a trade and provide an income for their families.

Last month, Norlah held a mentor ship class for young pastors' wives and young ladies that are married to church leaders. 40 women attended and she plans to continue the class every month to help guide and encourage these women in their ministry roles.



Norlah went to check on "Clair's Reading Camp for Kids" that she started in honour of Clair. The kids are doing well and are excited to be part of this program. Norlah's prayer is to be able to build a one room classroom building for this area. Norlah's love and desire to see children educated and give their lives to Christ, has been a driving factor in her daily life. Please pray for health and strength and wisdom for Norlah, as she reaches as many of these little ones for the kingdom of God!

We are so thankful for all the team members in each of the countries in Africa, who are giving of their time and talents for making a difference in so many lives for eternity!
